How to Forgive Yourself for Not Getting Rich & Famous in L.A. (Comedy) *Toni Sherwood*

Four film school grads from Chicago try to break into the L.A. film industry. Undaunted by self-sabotage, morally questionable choices, and unrestrained egoism, they may or may not make it, but at least they're among friends. It's like "Entourage," except nobody knows who they are.

Poserville (Comedy) Rich Tayloe

A mockumentary comedy series that follows the absurd mis-adventures of five 20-something wannabe artists; a geeky filmmaker, an indie-rocker, an "actre-vist," a fashion designer, and an aspiring reality TV star, as they struggle to make it in a world where it's survival of the hippest. (Austin Film Festival Top 10% and TV Writer.com Semi-finalist)

Promises, **Promises** (Comedy) *Ray DeFeis and Frank Cadillac* Life crisis. Mid-life crisis. And, after-life crisis. A middle-aged newlywed couple handle their careers while dealing with his annoying ex-wife, her eccentric 13-year-old love child, and the frighteningly obnoxious, very dead ex-husband.

Radiance Ambulance (Comedy)

Alex Sorrinni and Amber Redfield

Following the daily struggles and bizarre experiences of a short-staffed private ambulance service and the always-oncall employees who strive to keep their personal lives afloat.

Trolling (Comedy) Genna Rivieccio

On a nightly basis, Smoking Barrel and Moonchild troll the bars of what they call "Fake Brooklyn" (a.k.a. gentrified areas

of the borough) for what they call "pieces" (a.k.a. any guy who will buy them a drink), often resulting in surreal hijinks.

Coralillo (Drama) J.D. Osorio

In a country embroiled in civil strife, a young girl caught between two sides – and two men – acts as a catalyst for change.

Everybody Here (Drama) Michael E. Ross

Greg Reardon, a crafty, determined Seattle independent movie theater owner with a tortured past, fights the economy, developers, city bureaucracy, and a wealthy, ambitious ex-wife in order to keep his movie house alive in the nation's most culturally diverse neighborhood.

Harvey's Pump (Drama) Ace Passmore and Eric Small

An arrogant cardiologist, descendant of the Father of Cardiovascular Medicine, falls from grace and must resurrect himself – combining Eastern and Western medicine – to save his patients and survive his own heart malady. "House" meets "ER" – with heart! (Storyline by a prominent Houston cardiologist; represented by Peter Miller, Global Lion Intellectual Property Management, Inc.)

The Last McCool (Fantasy) Mark MacNicol

Celtic warrior Finn McCool travels through time to modern-day Boston to protect an ancient portal. In doing so he must recruit a trust fund playboy, Conor, the last McCool.

Sins of Our Fathers (Drama) J.M. Stifle

What do asbestos, a gay bathhouse, and a girl's visions have in common? The clash of culture and religion, freedom and repression, self-indulgence and the growing fear that marked the last gasp of the sexual revolution and the dawning of the era of AIDS. This 1980 NYC drama takes us from the heart of darkness to a state of grace.

Game Show

The Engagement Games (Drama) Lawrence Roberts

This TV game show separates an engaged couple into opposing teams with a desirable teammate for saucy games and bitter bouts, all week! The couple is driven to their emotional limits to discover the truth of their commitment.

Mini Series

City of Gold (Action/Adventure) Ricardo Espinosa

A legendary city of gold beckons a Spanish explorer to the New World, where he falls in love with an Indian princess. She helps him conquer an entire civilization, fulfilling an ancient, seemingly magical, Aztec prophecy.

The Man with Three Names (Drama) Scott Schlief

Small-town Michigan, 1969: 18-year-old Brent Lyle gets into a violent fight with his abusive, alcoholic father. Brent unintentionally kills him. He runs away from America to go into hiding and enlists in the elite French Foreign Legion, starts his epic adventurous life as a mercenary soldier, turned French police officer, turned serial vigilante in Chicago. (Book for adaptation. Represented by Michael Brandwein, Brandwein & Brandwein)

Denny and Gracie Collins met at a small Christmas party exactly 36 years earlier. Tonight, Gracie drops a bomb. She's selling their country cottage to move to a retirement community. But in one chaotic night, their love is rekindled, and new loves are sparked, all due to real and imaginary friends, a memory drug, drama therapy, a jewel thief, and indigestion.

Lisbon, AL (Comedy) Ann McDowell

After her husband goes to prison for a Ponzi scheme, a no longer up-and-coming New York socialite moves to a small Southern town to lick her wounds and prove she can still be queen bee somewhere. But the women of Lisbon, AL are not the pushovers she assumed they'd be.

She Was Left Alone (Biographical) Bela Wolf

When Bela happens by a local gathering of Siberian orphans, she doesn't expect to fall for young Karine. Her American sponsors drop her adoption due to lack of information in an unknown area. Now determined to adopt the child, Bela braves the harsh weather and political climate to fight daily obstacles and bring Karine home. Intense, emotional journey. (Represented by Whitt Brantley, WBMT Literary, Film, Television)

So Happy Together (Drama) *Briana Aeby*

On the verge of graduating high school, six soccer-loving senior girlfriends cope with the loss of one of their own after a night of typical teenage partying turns tragic.

Reality Shows

Relic Hunter (Non-Fiction/History) Alex Sorrinni

A reality show about the battlefields of old and what was left behind.

Sister Kristen Wants a Baby (Non-Fiction/History)

Kristen Maree Cleary

Coming off a period of great loss, and tired of living up to other people's expectations, the quintessential "good girl" decides to shake things up and embrace single motherhood.

Leon Cooper and Don Tait

The Hiroshima bomb enables a WWII Naval officer to escape death in his battles with the Japanese and with his "Captain Bligh" commanding officer.

Atoll 319 William E. Dyson III

Fictional Pacific Ocean action involving a small group of rescuers risking everything to preserve the freedom of the waterways. Who save sailors from an exploding freighter, battling high sea pirates involved in white slavery, surviving a plane crash on a deserted island, and learning to respect one another? (Book for adaptation)

Blackbird John Kovac

Twin brothers and their grandfather discover hidden amateur radio messages that cause problems for an Air Force black project. The International Space Station is also in danger. NASA and the Air Force must work together to pull the *Discovery* space shuttle out of the museum for a double rescue mission, but no one is to know about Blackbird

Crispus Caesar Thomas A. Simmons

A charismatic Roman prince only wants to live in peace with his young family, but first he must defeat barbarians, win a civil war, and change his father's murderous ways. Then there's the matter of his jealous, lecherous stepmother. (Based on real people and events)

The Criteria Sanguan Holland

In a world where self-expression and individuality is against the law, Jezebel, a young, rebellious Asian woman, joins Ken and an underground rebel organization so they can give people the freedom to be who they want to be.

Deka Logos Randall Tyson "Ty" Caudle

An elite double agent designs a killer virus that triggers a secret war around the world, pitting his specialized unit against the virus and an invasion with a new breed of human. Ten tales revolve around their epic battles to save mankind in the present day, as they ultimately test their faith in God and each other for the future.

Demons Can Die Darryl Burkett

The death of his father has caused him to seek revenge for his father's death. He just found out the demon in his hometown is responsible. He must track down the demon by following a woman who is the demon's daughter.

Dunamis: Faith Island *Armando Cuellar and Lisa B. Cuellar*

A faith healer competes against Satanists for big money and the soul of an orphan girl. "The Exorcist" meets "The Hunger Games."

The Fittest Sarah Brockmann

As relations between the U.S. and Venezuela deteriorate, the wife and young son of the Secretary of State are kidnapped by dangerous nationals, entangling him in a game of international deceit and ultimately forcing him to use his skills as a former Navy SEAL to go deep into the Venezuelan forest alone to rescue his family.

Good Bye Sarajevo Pedro Martinez

A hard-edged captain on a mission of humanitarian efforts in Sarajevo defies orders to remain neutral when he and his unit decide to help the people fight for their city.

Halloween with Dracula Carol Barker

A fun family movie where Mr. Relic wants Dracula brought back to life to rule a town that he sees has gotten out of hand. But unbeknownst to the current Tapas family, their little part in this is bloodier than they can imagine.

Hangar 19 Heist Stephen W. Killam

A former TV star must resurrect her lost skills to impersonate the sinister director of Area 52 and lead a team of disparate characters into top-secret Hangar 19, where they help a traveler from an alternate universe save our world from a cataclysmic seismic event.

High Stakes *Kelly Goodner*

Varied enemies and allies pursue cowardly, loner vampire Jack through a Key West hurricane, believing he is the oldest vampire – the Master – and he must survive or the world will end.

In Thy Lifetime *Johnny Johnston*

A military aerial crane expert defies a girl's longing prayer and airlifts an armored truck during transit, then slowly surrenders to find that from his choice of doing the right thing and returning the money is more difficult than it was to steal it.

Jawad's Bov Roni Kincaid

Years after an American hitchhiker's affair in pre-Munich-massacre Germany, the State Department tags her to help a 9/11 terrorist's family locate their son, the brother of her own boy.

Kiss with a Fist Alex Sorrinni

After a wild party, two strangers from different lifestyles wake together to find they are in the presence of a dead drug dealer's body, and are forced to work in tandem as they escape a local drug cartel's revenge for their dead companion.

Masked Identity Johnny Vangh

Ten years after his parents' murder, a peasant masquerades as a servant maid to infiltrate the royal castle and find the man who killed his parents.

Master of the 7 Disciples of Bruce Lee

Michael Anthony Phillips

A fanatical martial arts master seeks revenge on the seven legends associated with "Enter the Dragon" during the 40th anniversary tour of the movie.

Meilin – The Monkey King's Daughter Todd DeBonis

An insecure and bullied Chinese-American teen is shocked to discover the truth about her heritage and her ultimate destiny. Now she must find the courage needed to return to ancient mythical China and battle demons in order to save her family.

Murder of the Russian Priest T.N Kevin Ndango

A man obsessed by his vaulting ambition for a briefcase worth \$10 million gets trapped "in between" his mob employer with same ambition as his, and the Church he dies protecting, which possesses the "keys" to this great fortune.

Mustang Gordon Phipps

When the National Transportation Safety Bureau prematurely pulls the plug on an investigation into the inexplicable disappearance of a light aircraft and its pilot, the overly involved and over-committed Air Accident Investigator has to take the law into his own hands and face an airborne "High Noon"-type showdown to avenge the pilot's widow and bring the murderers to justice.

He and his team had a concept for an original Christmas MOW, but needed a strong writer to make it come to life on paper. Douglas had co-produced a film called Deadly Sibling Rivalry with producer John Murlowski, which InkTip scribe Steve Peterson had written. Recalling how easy Steve was to collaborate with, Douglas reached out to him for his Christmas project. "Steve has been great," said Douglas. "He writes super fast, which is always great for producers. We only had a few initial thoughts. Steve developed all the characters and story beats on his own."

The holiday film centers around a psychiatrist, Kate, played by Torrey DeVitto (*The Vampire Diaries*, *Pretty*

Little Liars), who attends to an unconscious man, Nick, played by Callard Harris (Dallas, Glory Daze), wearing a Santa Claus suit who saved her life during an earthquake. When Nick awakens and insists he is Santa, he is placed in the hospital's psychiatric wing. Soon his Christmas spirit "infects" everyone in the ward, and Kate falls for the man before she's able to find out his real identity. The film also stars Kenneth Choi (Sons of Anarchy, Burning Hollywood) as fellow inmate Jack, who has the delusion that he is Jack Nicholson's character from One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest.

Kate and Nick share the Christmas spirit. St. Nick and brought her comedic style to the set. "She was great to work with ... a great part of the team. We plan on working with her again for sure," said Douglas. As a lighthearted Christmas film, it needed someone like her to guide the actors and bring the comedy alive. The film has what Douglas calls a "zany gang comedy" element to it, similar to Hogan's Heroes or Animal House. Penelope's direction enriched the actors' performances of the wild and crazy personalities at the institution. "All the actors were great to work with, and they all did a wonderful job," said Douglas.

Douglas also praised his editor, Bob Joyce, for his skills in finding the laughs that translate on screen. "Comedy in general is hard," said Douglas. "What's funny on set doesn't always translate on screen. [Bob] did a great job milking the scenes for laughs. Major props to him."

With a strong writer, veteran director, great cast, and an editor you trust, producing a comedy hardly seems like a challenge. However, as with any production, there were some obstacles along the way. For one, they were

shooting a Christmas movie in the middle of summer in Southern California. As Douglas said, "Nuff said." But the days of green screen presented a challenge as well, or as Douglas put it, "a major pain in the a**." They had to match interior green screen shots with their exteriors. The van scenes had a ton of dialogue, so they opted to shoot them on green screen. "Looking back, we should have dealt with sound issues and rented a process trailer for all the van scenes. Lesson learned," Douglas explained.

The Real St. Nick premiered last December on Lifetime. Look for it again December 2013 and soon it will be available on DVD. In the

meantime, Douglas is keeping himself busy with a shoot this month and another one in July. "I love working with people, and I love the creative process. I feel like I'm exercising my brain every day because I'm also learning new things," he said.

We wish Douglas the best with his up-coming productions. When we asked him if he had any advice for screenwriters he said, "Do what you say you're going do and show up on time.... As a reader, if I'm interested after 120 pages, it's a great script. Don't worry about concept and plot so much. Keep it interesting."

Steve Peterson

Steve Peterson almost makes it look too easy. He's a self-taught screenwriter who tackled his first script after reading Syd Field's *Screenplay* and two scripts later was an optioned writer. That option gave him the encouragement to keep writing until the text "optioned writer" changed to "produced writer" on his résumé.

He was discovered on InkTip by director John Murlowski, who hired him to pen *Cop Dog*, a family film that graced the February 2009 cover of the InkTip magazine. Steve is back with another produced script, *The Real St. Nick*, which aired last December on Lifetime.



InkTip: You used to be based out of New York. Why did you make the move to L.A.?

Steve Peterson: I moved out in July 2011 because I was getting enough work that I felt I needed to be in the area and available to work directly with people instead of long-distance.

InkTip: Do you feel writers can still "make it" without moving to Hollywood?

Steve Peterson: There are many ways to succeed in film, and some of them

don't require moving to Hollywood. But you're cutting off a bunch of methods for having a career if you're relying purely on specs or contests. And given how competitive screenwriting is, it's best to have as many entryways as possible. I read an article about the head of a studio who quit to do screenwriting full-time – imagine competing with him!

InkTip: How did you meet Douglas Shaffer?

Steve Peterson: I met Doug Shaffer through John Murlowski. John was working with Doug on a film and brought me in to do a re-write on a script they had. Doug and his company apparently liked that enough to hire me to write a thriller for them from scratch and since then we've made a few films together.

InkTip: Was this a work for hire?

Steve Peterson: *The Real St. Nick* was an assignment. Stephanie Rennie, the development executive at Doug Shaffer's production company, came up with the idea, then we developed it into an outline, then I wrote the screenplay.

InkTip: What direction did you decide to take with the script and characters?

Steve Peterson: We ended up keeping it fairly light and frothy, though there's a serious story underneath for the two main characters. Much of the goofy fun comes from the ensemble characters in the mental institution. I had a lot of fun writing a character who had the delusion that he was a person from another story – Jack Nicholson from *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*.

InkTip: What are your favorite Christmas films? Did any of them help inspire *The Real St. Nick*?

Steve Peterson: *Miracle on 34th Street* is of course at the back of all of this, whether you've got a real Santa or just someone who thinks he's Santa. Since this story was set in a mental institution, we also looked toward *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* and *It's Kind of a Funny Story*.

InkTip: Were you on set for any of the shooting?

Steve Peterson: I was there for the whole thing. I love being on set. It's the time you get out of your writer's solitude. That said, production crews get up early and work long hours. And Penelope Spheeris directed this one – a total rock and roll grandma. That was awesome.

InkTip: There is a sense among some writers that selling their script for a direct-to-DVD or cable television production isn't "good enough." To them it has to be the silver screen or nothing. As a now seven-time produced writer, do you have any thoughts on that?

Steve Peterson: People who aren't in the business will think you're a failure if you're not Steven Spielberg or George Clooney. People who are in the business are extremely thankful that they get to pay the bills doing something as fun as this.

InkTip: What are you working on now?

Steve Peterson: Another Christmas comedy, on spec because I'd like to direct it: *The Escape Claus*.

InkTip: Anything you would like to add?

Steve Peterson: It'd be nice if they actually shot these little Christmas movies in winter instead of always in summer. Our poor lead actor, Callard Harris, had to tromp around the woods in a Santa outfit in July!

InkTip: Unfortunately, the winters in L.A. are too brutal for filming. Lows in the 60s and a 10% chance of rain. Can't chance it. Congrats on another produced script!
